Labbé heads to Delaware, a track where he has never competed. Fortunately, him and other drivers of the series could test the track 3 weeks ago. The young Can-Am driver ran a couple of fast laps under his belt. In that time, he's earned considerable knowledge of the track which will help to bring the dreamed victory.

With a solid win last season on oval, Labbé and the No. 32 Can-Am/Kappa Ford team will be looking to turn heads around in hopes of scoring yet another great performance Saturday.
