ALEX LABBE FINISHES 4TH IN PINTY'S GRAND PRIX TO EARN HIS FIFTH TOP-5 IN ROW

Toronto (Ontario, Canada) July 16, 2017 – Entering the race with high hopes to continue shinning with great results, Alex Labbe started 5th and finished 4th after completing 35 laps in the No. 32 Can-Am/Kappa Ford Fusion for Go FAS Racing (GFR) in the Pinty's Grand Prix of Toronto on Saturday afternoon.

The No. 32 team qualified 6th on Friday, but moved up to 5th on the starting grid since the No. 44 driver didn't attend the drivers' meeting. "We ran in 5th position for a couple laps until the No. 27 brought the second caution of the race," shared Alex Labbe. From there, Labbe raced over 20 laps standing in 4th. The Can-Am/Kappa Ford was actually showing faster paces then some drivers ahead. Although, it's when the No. 18 fell back to the field that Alex Labbe glide to 3rd.

“We had a fast Can-Am/ Kappa Ford, we carry out a good restart and I cleared myself in third, but our speed wasn’t enough on the straight line,” explained Alex Labbe that had to settle for 4th.

This fifth consecutive top-5 result marks a really successful beginning for Alex’s second full-time season. He remains second in the drivers’ standing with still many opportunities to overcome the gap between the actual leader, Kevin Lacroix.

The Can-Am/Kappa crew is looking forward to the upcoming 3 races that will be held on the beautiful West Coast of Canada.
