Las Vegas (California, USA) March 13, 2017 — Go FAS Racing's swing onto the West Coast is starting on a good foot as it seizes another great result for the team. Sunday in Sin City Matt DiBenedetto, once again, demonstrated his talent behind the wheel of the Ford Can-Am/Kappa No.32 car, finishing the Kobalt 400 with a 26th-place finish.

The No.32 team had to go through relentless hard work due to the heat on the track—to gain speed and a good car in the long run. The concern was causing a notable lack of grip and with the track invariability, it was rough to get all the adjustments right. Although, Gene Nead's crew recovered deftly from these conditions entering the third stage.

“Most every team was battling the car, and we were battling the same things” said Matt DiBenedetto. “The Ford Can-Am/Kappa car had a good speed but, it was hard to build drivability into the car. It was pretty consistently loose in, and tight off. It was hard to gain a good balance on the car, but Gene and the team made a lot of good adjustments to make it a lot better. Fortunately, our pit crew had many great pit stops and our team made phenomenal adjustments, and we ultimately gained more speed that brought us to a strong finish.”

The 2017 season is proof of a considerable progress for Archie St. Hilaire's small team. The first of the three stops in the West has the team sitting in the 22nd place in the owner points standings.

Matt DiBenedetto and the No.32 Can-Am/Kappa team will be heading to Phoenix International Speedway next weekend (Arizona, USA.).
